What will I be learning and doing?

When you first join the programme, we will discuss your learning needs and seek to understand exactly what you need to gain from the programme. Course topics include driving, health and safety, job search skills, budgeting, interview skills, employment rights and many more.

You will engage in a mixture of whole-class activities, individual and group work, and work experience.

What qualifications will I gain?

You will have the opportunity to gain nationally recognised qualifications, including:

- National Certificate in Employment Skills
- NCEA (Levels 1 & 2)
- National Certificate in Mathematics (L1)

Additional options include some study through the Open Polytechnic or the Correspondence School to supplement your learning with us.

We can also support you to achieve both your Learners and Restricted Drivers Licences.

FAQ Frequently Asked Questions:

How much does it cost?

This programme is funded by the Tertiary Education Commission and is free to eligible Youth.

What is the course format like?

This is a full year course. While you are on course you will be expected to gain at least 40 credits (NZQA unit standards) and a National Certificate. You will work as an individual and in a group to achieve your own goals. Your literacy and Numeracy will be assessed on the Assessment Tool. All students will be expected to improve their Literacy and Numeracy levels.

Are courses NZQA accredited?

All courses cover NZQA unit standards. The units you pass are entered onto your NZQA Record of Learning, so that if you go on to further training with another provider you won't have to redo any work you've done. Our courses provide an ideal foundation for anyone progressing on to higher tertiary qualifications.

Who do I see to apply?

Come in and speak directly to the course tutor of Learning4Earning on our Greymouth Campus.

How do I apply?

- Just call us up or drop in to arrange an interview. If you are eligible you will be accepted so long as:
- You must have officially left school and be either 15, 16 or 17 as at 30 January 2012
 - We have space,
 - **You are prepared to accept Karoro Learning's** rules and policies
 - You are determined to last the distance and complete qualifications
 - We believe that we can offer you the skills and support that you need to achieve your goals
