Literacy and Numeracy for Employment 2012



Karoro Learning's 'Moving Forward' course offers you the opportunity to develop your key skills in the following:

- Reading
- Writing
- Listening
- Speaking
- Numeracy
- Measurement

You will be assessed on The Adult Literacy and Numeracy Assessment Tool and together with your tutor you will set goals to increase your literacy and numeracy levels.



Course Details

Who will be in the class?

- There will usually be a maximum of 12 men and women from a variety of cultural backgrounds and of various ages whose goal is to improve their language communication skills (reading, writing, speaking and listening).

How will this class help me improve?

- This class will provide a friendly, supportive atmosphere which respects the cultural backgrounds of each participant. We will learn through a sharing, communicative approach. Each student will focus on their individual needs.

Eligibility –you can enrol in this class if you:

- are a New Zealand Citizen or Permanent Resident;
- are over the age of 16;
- need assistance to improve your reading, writing, listening and speaking skills;
- need assistance to improve your numeracy skills.

Course Hours

How much time will it take?

- 14 hours per week. Four mornings per week

Enrolment

- Students may enrol throughout the year, each programme is for 100 hours
- Depending on numbers, a waiting list may apply

What is the cost?

- There is no financial cost – just your time and commitment. The Government covers the cost of your classes.

Where do we learn?

- Classes are held at Karoro Learning, 180 Tainui Street, Greymouth. There may be some off campus visits to places of interest.

Can I leave when I want to?

- You may decide to leave when you have met your learning goals.
